

Current Hours of Operation

Friday, Saturday, Sunday from 10:00 am-7:00 pm For your safety, the water closes before sunset each day.

Operating Information

- Gaming zone with outdoor games, beach volleyball and kiddie slide available daily
- Nightlife & entertainment each Friday night (Karaoke, Bingo, Trivia etc.) and it's just the beginning
- Full liquor bar is available in Cabana Cove
- Select retail items (towels, sunblock, beach toys, ice cream) available for purchase
- Kids Club (Crafts/Activities) are available each Saturday and Sunday from 11 am-2 pm
- Food trucks are available on-site each day from 11 am-6 pm (schedule subject to change)
- Kayaks and Paddleboards can be rented at \$12 + tax per "1-hour" session/per person*
- Aquabanas can be rented the day of, on-site at check-in, for \$249 + tax for the entire day*
- Residents can bring their own chairs for a temporary time period
- Pool noodles, inner tubes, and baby/children's floats allowed, no large floats will be allowed
- Swim zones will be increased as the rest of the Lagoon continues to open
- Floating adventure course coming to SSB Lagoon in early 2022
- No pets are allowed in the Lagoon with the exception of service animals
- No outside food and beverage are allowed. Closed or empty water bottles ONLY (nothing larger than a backpack-sized soft cooler)

Resident Guest Passes

- 25 guest passes are issued per household/per year, unused guest passes do not roll over and refresh on January 1 of each year
- Additional \$5 guest passes can be purchased "day of" entry at the Lagoon
- Residents must check-in with guests in order for guests to enjoy the Lagoon

The remaining sections and swim zones of the lagoon are diligently being worked on so that we can get them up and running for your future enjoyment.

Resident discounts do not include food, beverage, or guest passes
